Before You Begin

To register for StatCrunch you will need:

- ☒ **Your school's zip code: 94545**
- ☒ **A StatCrunch student access code** (packaged with your new text or available for purchase at www.statcrunch.com).
- ☒ **A valid email address**

Registering for StatCrunch

1. Enter www.StatCrunch.com in your web browser.
2. On the left menu, click "**Subscribe.**"
3. Under Students, click "**Redeem an Access Code**" if you already have your code. If you need to purchase access, click a link to "Purchase."
4. Read the License Agreement and Privacy Policy and click "**I Accept.**"
5. On the Access Information Screen, you'll be asked whether you already have a Pearson Education Account. Click:
 - "**YES**" if you have registered for other Pearson online products and already have a login name and password. Boxes will appear for you to enter your existing login information.
 - "**NO**" if this is the first time you have registered for a Pearson online product. Boxes will appear for you to create your login name and password.
 - "**NOT SURE**" if you want to check for a pre-existing account and receive an email with your login name and password.
6. Type in your **Access Code** in the fields provided (one word per field) and click **Next**.
7. Simply follow the registration screens and enter your information as prompted. You will enter your name, email address, school information and provide a security question/answer to ensure the privacy of your account.

Once your registration is complete, you will see a **Confirmation** screen (this information will also be emailed to you). Simply print your confirmation - you are now ready to Log in and access your resources!

Logging in

1. Enter www.statcrunch.com in your web browser.
2. Enter the **Login Name ID** and **Password** you created and click "**Sign In!**" You are now ready to access your resources!
